

All games are played on NASA Langley Research Center grounds. Where games are played on the grounds depends on the season and the weather.

Generally speaking, during summer and the warmer parts of spring and fall, we play outdoors on a field we call the “power plant field”. We call it this because it’s across the road from a power plant. The field itself is just a field; it hasn’t been crowned or leveled, and other than the weekly mow it doesn’t get any special soccer-related attention. There are a couple metal benches available. Restroom access is available but not convenient. A nearby building has restrooms but card key access is required to enter the building.

During winter we play indoors in the NASA Langley Research Center gym (building 1222B). The gym floor has a hard basketball court surface. There are changing rooms for both men and women, restrooms, and water fountains.

Be aware that in order to access the field to play with us YOU MUST have a valid NASA-issued badge. Badges issued by Langley Air Force Base do not count. This is a requirement of NASA LaRC security, not the club. Guards do occasionally stop by games to check badges, so for your own benefit please take this requirement seriously.
